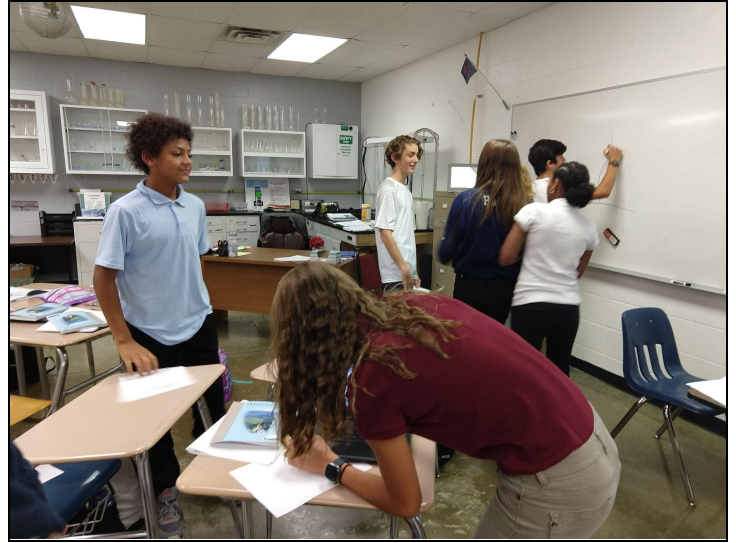
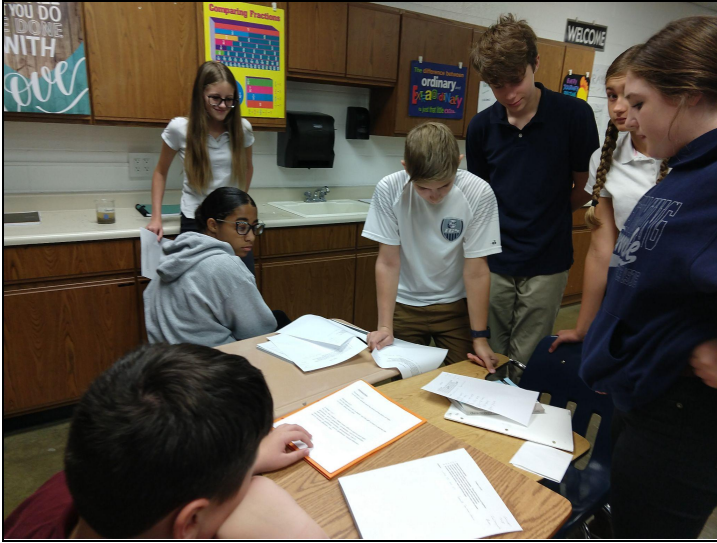
3rd Grade Field Trip

Elementary music programs and spring musicals - gave money to help offset the cost of the productions and purchased sound equipment

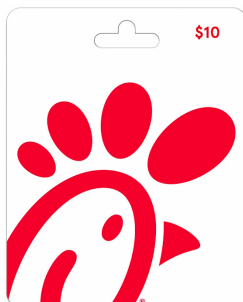
