



In pairs, students presented the weather for two days in two Spanish-speaking capital cities—adding a fun twist with imaginative forecasts, props, and interactive dialogue. From raining tacos in Mexico City to empanada-shaped lightning in Buenos Aires, the forecasts were anything but ordinary. Each presentation included unique weather expressions, high and low temperatures, and a full Spanish conversation. Using eye-catching Google slides and rehearsed scripts (no reading allowed!), students balanced speaking time, engaged the audience, and showcased their Spanish skills in a lively, memorable way. 
Exploring the Science of Density:

Bible 10 students recently completed a creative project centered on the story of Job. After researching each section of the book, students worked in groups to write

skits that retold the events in their own words. These presentations brought the story to life, highlighting Job's trials, perseverance, and unwavering faith. This activity not only deepened students' understanding of Scripture but also allowed them to engage with the text in a meaningful and memorable way, demonstrating both thoughtful study and creativity in sharing biblical truth.
