Students rotated through various radiology areas, including ultrasound, X-ray, MRI, and CT scan, where they learned about imaging technology and its role in diagnosing patients. They also visited the occupational therapy department, observing how therapists help patients regain strength and independence. This valuable experience gave students an inside look at potential healthcare careers and how their classroom learning connects to real-world medical practice.
