Apologetics 1 Students Lead Peer Teaching Presentation



Six talented students from Apologetics 1 recently took on the role of teachers, delivering two dynamic presentations to their peers in Bible 11. The presenters — Shea Lynn Rager, Nolyn Wright, Braxton Hoover, Zach Metz, Caynan Schick, and Jake Carge — did an outstanding job explaining the historical evidence of Jesus Christ found in external writings by notable ancient historians such as Tacitus, Flavius Josephus, and Pliny the Younger.

Their well-prepared and engaging presentation tied directly into Bible 11's current study on "The Reliability of the Bible." Through the use of peer teaching, these students helped bridge the gap between biblical truth and historical scholarship, offering their classmates clear biblical, archaeological, and historical verification for the life and ministry of Jesus Christ.

One of the most exciting aspects of their presentation was the discovery that even non-Christian writers — men who did not follow Christ — still acknowledged His existence, miraculous works, and crucifixion under Pontius Pilate. This compelling evidence reinforced that faith in the Scriptures is both spiritually and historically well-founded. The spirit of this project beautifully reflected the motto of Apologetics, drawn from 1 Peter 3:15-16: "Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have."

Through their preparation, teamwork, and passion, these six students exemplified what it means to "give a reason" for what they believe — encouraging their peers to stand confidently in the truth of God's Word.

Fourth grade students enjoyed indoor recess this week.










